




The Death Star had to be destroyed, or the flickering flame of freedom would die. All Rebel fighters met at Fleet

R2-D2 beeped happily at C-3PO. But the golden droid shook his head. "No, I don't think 'exciting' is the right word, Artoo."










Leia spun around to see an Imperial scout. He yanked her roughly to her feet. "Surrender, Rebel spy!"

"She didn't come back? We'd better start looking for her."


C-3PO followed the others off into the woods. "Don't worry, Master Luke. With Artoo's scanner we'll find the princess."






C-3PO listened to their squeaky language. "They're Ewoks, Master Luke. I'll try and speak with them."

Luke whispered to Leia. "I must go to the Death Star and try to save Darth Vader. There is good in him. You see, he is my father."











