CONFLUENCE REVISITED By Brian Aldiss

When an Earth ship discovered the Myrinian system, the planet Myrin's civilization was already eleven million years old. The Myrinians traced their history back that far; they had erected a memorial of vertiginous beauty to the passing of the ages every million years, either in reverence or fun.

Most of that lengthy period was passed in what one Earth philosopher has termed 'fruitful stagnation'. Stagnant or not, the Myrinian cultural complex is to be envied for the general level of contentment in which its peoples live, referred to as *Bi Jo* (approximately, Stylized Submerged Individualism). The people eat moderately and sleep well at night.

Bringing back with it many records of the venerable Myrinian culture, the Tenth Research Fleet has just returned to Earth, android-manned, since the human crew in the main elected to remain on Myrin in the state referred to as First Lobby. Unfortunately it has not yet proved possible to receive a visitation here from representatives of the Myrinian system, despite many pressing invitations. Doubtless we may expect acceptances when levels of radiation decrease. Meanwhile, terrestrials must be grateful that Myrin does not ban all human visits. Even the unfortunate incident involving the Earth ship *Bombast* has been clemently overlooked.

The complexity of the chief Myrinian language, Confluence, has already been noted. That it is a language-cum-posture, or lingopost, was established by the Seventh Research Fleet, members of which were privileged to attend special lectures at the Oeldrid Stance Academy on Myrin Centre, in Sector Ten. Meanings in lingopost can be radically altered by the stance assumed by the speaker (or *S'lh Hin*, the Intoner, also a rather transparent curtain), or even by that of the listener. The positioning of a single finger can negate or reverse the meaning of several classes of lingopost words. It is clear that there is no possibility of compiling a dictionary within the ordinary meaning of the term.

The Tenth Research Fleet was confined to Sector Nine on the chief Myrinian planet. As is well known, the Myrinians have for convenience (or some say for amusement) divided their territories into squares, so that they resemble a gigantic checker-board. There the researchers spent considerable time investigating Confluence. Their special report on terms for wine will be published separately.

They also compiled a holographic record of various stances assumed in lingopost. Findings will be available shortly.

Meanwhile, the brief listing that follows displays something of the interest of a lingopost which far excels Solar English in its nuances. Definitions must be regarded as tentative.

The romanized phonetic system employed here is that suggested by the leader of the Etymological Division of the Seventh Research Fleet, Dr Rohan Harbottle.

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AH BLAK HOO Oblong eyes; the inhabitants of Sector Nine say that persons with oblong eyes live longest

AH SHEN SHI Having learnt any classical book by heart

AK IH WAN Courtesy to an old lady in cognizance of her previous beauty; an qovercooked egg or fish

ANEY A place much used by great-grandfathers

ARP RUH HIG LO TON Being busy in an office after lunch; a dotard studying history; sounds of leaves falling in early autumn

ARTH Conversation; a cave with echoes

AS DIN A family holiday less than a complete success; a fever

BACH HOANG A machine factory; a long worm in a tiger's intestine

BA YEF NA One's recognizably second-rate thoughts

BAZ YEF HO Striving to better one's thoughts; restocking a lake with fish of improved quality

BI A reverie sustained for twenty years; crowing like a cockerel without making a sound

BI JOWA Ninety per cent contentment; half of a chocolate egg

BOL I PEIU Those who worship tigers; perhaps a ceiling with blood on it

CH'N DOGBA HAN The kind of conversation one expects between two robots; singing for the sake of it

CHUK CHEE Answering back to owls; laughing at one's own jokes; a concoction of raw egg and alcohol

CHU PAT A learned person in a low tavern

CUR Persistent attempts at flight; any hilarious suicide

DA EST KO A hypothetical form of reason which will reach to the roots of unreason, at present being developed by sages in Sector Nine

DI CHI'FAN I The laughter of women in the next room; restaurants with doubtful reputations

DOBGAT An irresistible tendency to laugh at what is not funny

FAN Beloved female

FANG TO A rarity; cream on mare's milk

FAN N'M A slightly less beloved female

FANOW A surprisingly pleasant female cousin; a miniature painting

FAN SEE KIT MEE An undiscovered continent; a well-cultivated female mind; cream

FEE MAABA An obsolete weapon once used for beheading robots; the shinbone

FEET A kind of hedgehog skilled at climbing trees; old hair brushes

FOH TAT A dog singing; laughter towards nightfall

HA LIT A special dish of jelly fish; jokes told to the wrong people

HANG TAK A robot which thinks it thinks

HE'CHI YAY Borrowing and not returning books; a certain smile

HE HANG TUK TI A robot which thinks it can walk straight but deviates to the left consistently

TATI YI Discerning the differing qualities of each hour of darkness; 'parting the night breeze'
